Throughout our history, we have developed partnerships with not-for-profit organizations, collaborated with grassroots groups and supported community initiatives demonstrating that our approach to city-building puts people at the centre.

In 2020, we announced a new location partnership with Studio.89, a non-profit community hub serving fair-trade coffee to fund community programs related to sustainability, conscious consumerism, community dialogue and youth leadership. Located within our Daniels Erin Mills Presentation Centre at Arc Condominiums, Studio.89 seeks to empower community to act locally and think globally for a sustainable future. With Daniels' support over the last three years, Studio.89 has become a neighbourhood favourite; hosting programs and events accessible to the broader Erin Mills community.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Partnership is key to the affordable housing solution.

There are many financial barriers that can separate individuals and families from a safe and affordable place to call home. At Daniels, we've created pathways to affordable homeownership for hundreds of families through partnerships, innovation and financial assistance programs.

Daniels is proud to have built more affordable homes than any other private sector company in Canada. For over 25 years, Daniels has partnered with Habitat for Humanity GTA and local affiliates to empower families in need of a safe and affordable place to call home.

In 2008, Daniels donated land to Habitat for Humanity for the construction of 10 townhomes in Lakeshore Village in Etobicoke — the single largest donation of land by a private company in Habitat Canada's history. To date, Daniels has contributed over \$6 million to Habitat for Humanity, which has resulted in safe, affordable and healthy homes for over 90 Habitat partner families across the GTA.





FOOD AND URBAN AGRICULTURE

Food and urban agriculture grow healthy, vibrant communities.

We recognize the role that a sense of community and connection plays when it comes to overall health and well-being. That's why we create shared spaces and experiences that bring people together. We built our first rooftop garden in 2009, and now incorporate opportunities for urban agriculture across our portfolio of communities. In fact, between 2021-2022, we built 284 new urban agriculture plots and engaged 400 new residents in garden programming.

Taking our commitment to food and urban agriculture to the next level, Daniels worked with residents in the broader Erin Mills community to establish the Erin Mills Farmers' Market not-forprofit in 2016. 





These standard layouts include accessible features such as power-operated entry door roughin, wider doors throughout, roll-in showers, and roll-out balconies, to name a few.



The Kith Condominiums is pursuing the Gold rating from the Rick Hansen Foundation Accessibility Certification[™] (RHFAC) program. This program is designed to challenge developers like Daniels to go beyond the building code and create innovative solutions to make their communities universally accessible. Taking the approach of designing for accessibility and keeping inclusivity top of mind at every stage of the development process helps us to ensure that every resident can love where they live.

Daniels is on a mission to decarbonize the real estate industry in the Greater Toronto Area by focusing on the Whole Life Carbon impact of the homes we design and build. Our plan is detailed in our Decarbonization Roadmap, which positions Daniels as a leader in innovative and sustainable construction practices.

Daniels is publishing a carbon label that further breaks down Whole Life Carbon to quantify the emissions reduction from the innovative features and technologies implemented in new development projects. This label was developed as a means for voluntary disclosure of carbon performance to enhance our continuing efforts to decarbonize the homes we build. The carbon label shows the total carbon footprint for each square metre of floor area, combining both upfront and operating carbon emissions.

WHOLE LIFE CARBON INTENSITY

The Kith Condominiums was one of Daniels' pioneering communities to be studied for Whole Life Carbon Intensity and is included in our Emissions Baseline. By quantifying and reporting the carbon impact of our new communities, we aim to see continuous improvement over time to reach the goals outlined in our Daniels' Decarbonization Roadmap.

UPFRONT CARBON

A Whole Building Lifecycle Assessment was performed to study the key drivers of upfront carbon. Concrete and rebar were found to be the largest contributors, making up over 80% of the upfront emissions. This information is key to continuously improving our construction practices to find low-carbon alternatives in the future.

OPERATING CARBON

At The Kith Condominiums, energy-saving measures are already in place to improve thermal comfort, reduce fossil-fuel consumption and lower energy costs, such as efficient in-suite mechanical systems with energy recovery ventilation and low-flow plumbing fixtures.

Carbon emissions intensities are projections based on energy and lifecycle assessment modeling of Daniels communities during design; methodologies can be found in our Decarbonization Roadmap.
